I. Officers' Reports

A. Treasurer's Report—Treasurer absent

 - Concerns were raised regarding the adequacy of current sewer system to handle the additional load generated by this development.
3. Joe Power's (Canadian Honker) parking lot zoning change request.

B. Mike encouraged us to help plant trees at Manor Park April 24th (meet at 9am). There are 500 trees to plant. A free lunch will be provided.
