- I. Officers' Reports
 - A. Treasurer's Report—None

- II. Rochester Public Safety
 - A. Joe Powers
 - Mr. Powers attended to express his discontent with the results of recent public meetings centered on neighborhood crime and policing. He is attempting to form a grassroots advisory group to start a public safety initiative including the demand for more officers on Rochester streets. First steps will include meeting with Neighborhood Watch captains to determine problem areas in the city.

 - Pam made a motion to use \$350 of KPNA funds to upgrade the website. Motion seconded and carried.

 - B. *Imagine Kutzky/First Homes*—Chris Flood
 - The final plan for the Second Street Corridor project will be presented to the Rochester Planning Commission on Oct. 14. If approved, it will go to City Council. Information on the plan can be found at www.secondstreetcorridor.org
 - *First Homes* is currently attempting to channel some funds slated for purchasing foreclosures to rehabbing 1126 W. Center Street.

 - A. City Council Report—Michael Wojcik
 - Michael is calling for a moratorium on development in the Second Street corridor that doesn't meet the guidelines of the planning study. This would be in effect until the study itself is passed. President Edmonson has drafted a letter of support for this interim ordinance on behalf of KPNA.
 - Michael has requested a public hearing concerning sewer rates. He is dissatisfied with the fact that 2/3 of the \$60 million expansion is being subsidized by existing developments and would like to propose his own rate structure.
